"BAD NEWS" SPREADERS  
OFTEN SEEK OWN PROFIT

Occasionally, a broker or salesman of doubtful reputation attempts to feather his own nest by spreading bad news about certain securities. He will inform you and volunteer the information by a personal call—that certain stock which he knows you own, is due for a bad "break," and that you had better get out while you can.

Many cases have been reported where the real facts concerning such stock are exactly the opposite of those represented by the spreaders of bad news. Naturally his purpose is to sell you out of the stock in question, in order that he may acquire it for himself and reap the benefit of any subsequent and secretly expected rise in price.

By this spreading of bad news, bona fide owners of bona fide securities are frequently victimized in this manner.

Legitimate brokers and salesmen—and this type are happily

in the great majority—discount-

ance such methods.

While legitimate houses aim to keep regular customers informed of impending "breaks" or cases they do not "spread" bad news through the medium of salesmen making unsolicited calls on strangers.


Get the facts first. Do not be stampeded into hasty, ill-advised action.—Better Business Bureau.

"Tears" in Old Glasses

Not Shed by Weepers

One of the things greatly demanded by antique hunters in Europe are "tear glasses." These are said to be Patholite (Marsala) little glasses in the slender stems of which is imprinted a small portrait of a weeping artist torn. It looks very touching, but it is deceiving. The "tear" never came from a sorrowing eye. It is merely a drop in the glass—accidental at first and skillfully tended later, but the name itself, with the size of the article, is enough to make it sought after.

Like the tear glasses of modern Europe were famous "tear vases," or late symmetries of the ancient Greeks and Romans. These were small vessels of bronze or silver, usually found in houses and in which the mourners were supposed to have dropped their tears. It has been decided, however, that they were used to contain ingredients—something regularly and seriously used in ancient funerals.


