TRADING CONTRACT ON PROPERTY HAZARDOUS

A few disreputable real estate firms advertise:

For Exchange—Real Estate Will exchange equity on income duplex for two beautiful lots; rare bargain. Telephone Gr. 1221. Says the advertiser's salesman: "I am prepared to buy your \$4000 equity in this house and lot, and on which you are paying \$50 per month on land contract, if you'll take contracts on two choice lots as part payment. Pay only \$10 per month on these new contracts. Look at them. \$500 has already been paid in on each."
"What will I do with my contract to buy this house?" asks the victim. "Simply assign it to the A B Corporation," replies the salesman. "It will make the payments and relieve you of all responsibility."

The victim assigns the first contract to the A B Corporation, but finds that it does not keep up the payments, as promised. The original seller, or the person from whom the victim originally purchased the duplex, immediately threatens foreclosure. The victim is now liable on three contracts, his first obligation and his two contracts on the lots. His assignment did not relieve him of liability.

The quoted price of \$3,000 for lot was a fraudulent inflation. Their value was only \$1200 each. The victim therefore swears a good \$4000 equity for a \$2400 value, with \$1000 in cash still to pay. The advertiser, to add insult to injury, demands a commission, too.

The A B Corporation is a dummy company, formed by the real estate concern as a part of its scheme to move vacant subdivision property.
Legitimate real estate dealers are actively cooperating in combatting and exposing such deals.

The facts are being reported to the Michigan Securities Commission for proper punitive action. Before you invest—Investigate!—Better Business Bureau.
