### FURS MAY BE RETAINED TO GET BETTER PRICES

No permits are required by trappers to retain legally caught furs, in possession for better market prices, according to the Department of Conservation. If trappers comply with the law and send reports to the Department offices at Lansing after the close of the respective trapping seasons, listing the numbers and kinds of furs on hand, these furs may be kept as long as desirable without permits and without any other formalities. Fur dealers may also purchase furs at any time after the close of the various seasons, provided they determine that the furs purchased have been reported by the trappers to the Department.

### NEW OAKLAND MOTORS ARE EQUIPPED WITH A NEW "SYNCHRONIZER"

Among the new inventions responsible for the smoothness with which the Oakland V-type Eight delivers its tremendous power, is a simple and ingenious device bearing a newly-coined name—the "Synchronizer." It operates in conjunction with a new type of front engine mounting—two sets of flat laminated springs that absorb the normal operating reactions of the motor by permitting a very slight horizontal movement at the forward end of the power plant. Two rubber-cushioned mountings anchor the rear of the engine securely to the car frame. The function of the "synchronizer" is to permit this normal microscopic movement at the front of the engine, while preventing the motor under the impact of road shocks, from exceeding that movement. The "synchronizer" so named because it synchronizes with the normal rate of engine reactions, provides between the front of the engine and the car frame a restraining tie rod which limits the horizontal movement.
