The function of the "synchronizer" is to permit this normal microscopic movement at the front of the engine, while preventing the motor, under the impact of road shocks, from exceeding that movement. The "synchronizes with the normal rate of engine reactions, provides between the front of the engine and the car frame a restraining tie rod which limits the horizontal movement.
