Swim Classes To Begin Dec. 2

Hourly swimming instruction for adults will be offered by the Farmington City Recreation Department from 7 to 9 p.m., Monday nights, beginning Dec. 2.

Classes will be held in Clarendonville High School with registration set for the opening session. Classes will meet weekly through Feb. 17.

Student swim classes will be offered on Saturdays with the times to be announced.

Open swimming, now underway, will run until March 31. The pool is open from 7 to 9 p.m., Wednesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays. Sunday afternoon swimming takes place from 2 to 4 p.m. The cost of hourly swim segments is 25 cents for students; 50 cents for adults. The height requirement is 48 inches.

A meeting of basketball team captains is scheduled for 1:30 p.m., Saturday Dec. 21 in Farmington City Hall. Six teams have indicated an interest in joining the league. An entry fee of \$50 per team will be assessed and interested merchant sponsors are asked to contact the recreation department in City Hall. Games will be played on Monday nights in Farmington Junior High School.

The recreation department reports large turnouts by city residents for its activities. Gymnasium classes are almost at capacity, as well as swim classes. Residents enrolled in the Latin-American dance class have learned the cha cha, rumba and samba and are about to begin sessions in the tango.

Plans are now being made for the winter program, with a men's basketball league, chess club and class on American dances to be added to the present program. Information will be announced at a later date.
