TAX LIMITATION BY ASKED IN PETITION

Stephen Tredway Circulates Pet-ition In Farmington; Has 60 Signatures

A tac-limitation movement that has cleated some discussion in the lower part of the State reached Farmington this week, when Stephen Tredway, Farmington citizen began circulating copies of the petition for amendment of the State Constitution so as to prevent taxes going above a certain percentage of the property valuation.

Mr. Tredway repofted only one refusal to sign the petition, and about 60 names obtained Thursday mbrning. The petition would provide for an amendment, whereby total taxes on property for the year could not exceed one and one-half per cent of the assessed valuation, except for taxes to pay interest and principal payments on obligations heretofore incurred.

The limitation, according to the petition, might be increased for a period of not over five years to not over 5 per cent, by a two-thirds votes of the electors of any district or where provided by city charter, which is the case with Farmington City.

The limitation would not apply to 1932 taxes.

While the movement met with fayorable comment as likely to have a good psychological effect, toward he exercise of economy, it has been also declared impractical, because of the necessity of meeting certain fixed charges every year, which cannot be avoiled.
