The ultimate goal is to reduce accidents, traffic fatalities and injury - producing accidents, says Holko, and this has been a result experienced by other cities which have participated in this program.

THE TRAFFIC bureau will operate on a day and afternoon shift with two patrolmen to each shift.

An officer will be appointed to head the bureau making a total of five members. When situations demand, Holko says, the regular patrol will be used for traffic work.
