FORMER RESIDENT DIES IN DETROIT: WAS 81 YEARS OLD
 Miss Minnie Collins Was Daughter Of First White Child Born In Farmington
 Miss Minnie Collins, former well-known resident of Farmington, died at the home of a sister in Detroit, Monday. Miss Collins was 81 years old.
 The deceased was a daughter of John Collins, the first white child born in Farmington. Her grandfather, George Collins, with his wife came to Farmington from New York State in 1926 and were among the first settlers of the town. The family was prominent in civil and social affairs. The father of the deceased held the office of postmaster in Farmington for 21 years.
 Miss Collins is survived by two sisters, Mrs. Jessie Lee of Farmington and Mrs. Corine Bush of Detroit. A cousin, Gale Collins, is well-known in Farmington.
