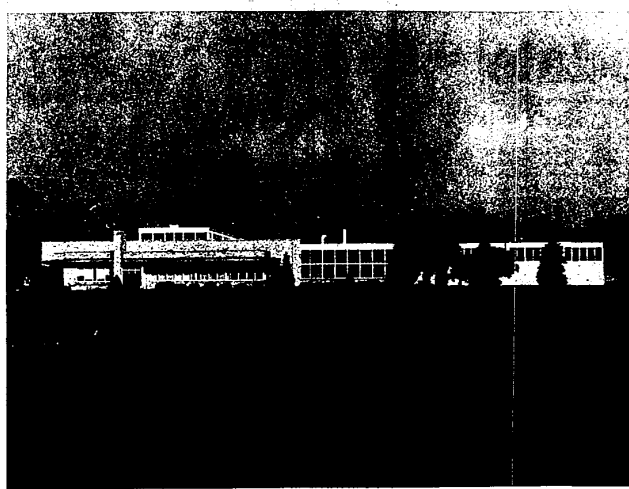

Doubtful Eye On C'ville Pact

The Clarenceville Board of Education has come under the eye of the Michigan Press Assn. for holding a closed-door meeting.

The Clarenceville board went into a private session behind closed doors Sept. 9-10 Assn. for holding a closed-door meeting to discuss and ratify a contract with the teachers union.

Elmer E. White, executive secretary of the press group, said in a letter to Observer Newspapers:

"ACCORDING TO

Michigan law, no action taken by a public board in an executive session is legally binding. If the board of education did not vote in a public meeting to accept the teachers' contract, there is room to argue that the ratification is not proper."

Observer reporter W. Edward Wendover covered the meeting and recalled:

"The meeting in question went into closed session about 11:30 p.m. I waited around Dave (Supt. David McDowell) said he didn't know anybody was out there and that the board just declared the meeting open without announcing it to those they had expelled from the room (I was the only one left) and OK'd the contract."

"But Dave knew I was waiting for a copy of the contract, which he wouldn't give me until after the board voted. The meeting let out after 1 a.m."

"I saw Dave after they broke up, and he gave me a copy of the (new) contract and last year's contract as well."

Boards of education usually apply the term "executive" to closed-door, secret meetings, although such boards are policy-making rather than executive bodies.

White's letter to Observer Newspapers was his own idea and was not solicited by the newspaper.

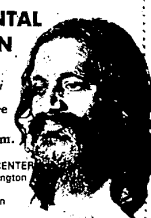

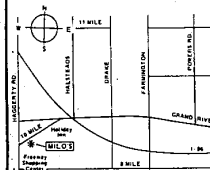
