Oakland Dem Move Aimed At Dan Murphy?

In what Republican members of the Oakland County Board of Commissioners termed a "political power play," a 14-11 Democratic majority party vote created a third full time position on the board of auditors Thursday.

Republicans see the action as a maneuver to dump GOP-appointed chairman Daniel Murphy and to appoint a "political puppet" who will respond to the Democratic majority.

Murphy says he will resign from the board if he loses his \$35,000 a year chairmanship.

SINCE 1965, the board of auditors has had two full time members. One has a salary of \$27,000 with an additional \$7,575 for being chairman, and a part-time position at \$7,500. The part-time position will be abolished as a result of the commission action.

Dissatisfaction with Murphy recently erupted when auditors approved \$100,000 in back pay for the county's nine circuit judges. Some Democrats called the action "a blatant disregard" for elected officials' position as spokesmen for the people.

No ADC Clothing Funds In Oakland

A supplemental 1971 clothing allowance program for children of ADC recipients in Oakland County remains in limbo. The County Board of Commissioners is unable to reach agreement on funding.

From December 1970 through April of this year, the county appropriated \$124,700 to provide emergency school clothing for 3,319 children.

The human resources committee could not arrive at a consensus and brought the matter to the full board Thursday.

"THE PROBLEM is money and the fact that we are faced with a deficit," said Paul Kasper (R-Bloomfield Hills). "This is a secondary program and we can't even take care of our primary needs. Until there are funds for general relief, we can't take care of the clothing program."

Wallace Gabler (R-Royal Oak) pointed out that 632 persons were removed from the county's general welfare rolls and \$500,000 in assistance funds cut back to save money.

"These people are getting nothing," he asserted. "There are 107 appeals by general aid recipients to the Social Services Dept. so how can we

Kensington Park Viewed By Artist

There's a new special exhibit entitled "An Artist's Impression of Kensington Park" now on display at the park's nature center.

for the job, not a political hack," one observer in the audience said. "If they do, they'd better answer to the public."

"Democrats have been trying to get rid of Murphy as chairman for three years, but they didn't have enough votes. Now they have."

William Mainland (D-Milford) the only Democrat to vote against the action, said creation of the full time auditor's position would not serve the public better.

"We took the first step to centralizing board of auditors' responsibility in 1965, and some commissioners feel the board should be eliminated and a county chief executive appointed. Now we're going in the opposite direction."

Powell called the action "reactionary" and one that takes advantages of the taxpayers and creates more divisiveness.

PATNALES said, "I thought we took political appointees out of government. Who needs a job now? After one year of Democratic influence, the county is in the red and creating jobs and political situations."

"If we appoint a full-time auditor for three years at a salary in excess of his ability, it will be a political plum. We'll have one more chief and we'll need more Indians to do the work."

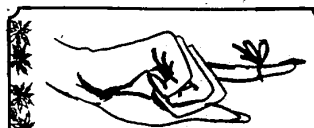
