How Long To Kick The Habit?

Q. How long does it take to cure a drug addiction. This is very important to me... Will you please answer as soon as you can. I've heard that if you really try you can "kick" a habit in less than a week.

A. R.D., Westland

A. We are asked this, or similar questions, with great regularity. There seems to be a great misunderstanding about the nature of addiction and what is a true cure.

In the light of a report published in the Oct. 25 "Journal of the American Medical Association" by the AMA Council on Mental Health and its committee on alcoholism and drug dependence, we can perhaps give a better answer than would have been possible before.

First of all, "kicking a habit" in less than a week is possible. This is called withdrawal but is not a cure. Almost anyone who has had an addiction over a long period of time has probably withdrawn a number of times.

The key to the article referred to above is the following sentence: "Once established, drug dependence of the morphine type, has the characteristics of a chronic, relapsing disorder."

Recovery is considered to have occurred only if the following criteria are met:

- 1) "...continually abstinent from the drug... for a period of three years."
- 2) "...remains, during this time, free of abuse of other psychoactive (i.e. mind-altering) drugs, including the abuse of alcohol."
- 3) "...does not suffer significantly from drug-related social and economic disability or incapacity."
- 4) "...does not suffer from a psychological disability which represents a continuation... of his drug dependence."

Now, obviously, some of this is arbitrary—such as the three year abstinence—but these criteria, sadly, are more reflective of the course of recovery from addiction than the general attitude that prevailed only a few years ago.
