

COMMISSIONERS' PROCEEDINGS

Regular meeting of the City Commission held February 6, 1934. Called to order by Mayor Lamb at 7:42 P. M. Commissioners present, Hamlin, Stamann, Goers, Hatton and Osmus.

Commissioner Goers made a report on street lighting and told of the adjustment made by the Detroit Edison Company and the committee from the City Commission. Motion made by Hamlin, seconded by Stamann that the report be adopted. Carried, yeas: Osmus, Goers, Hamlin, Stamann and Hatton.
