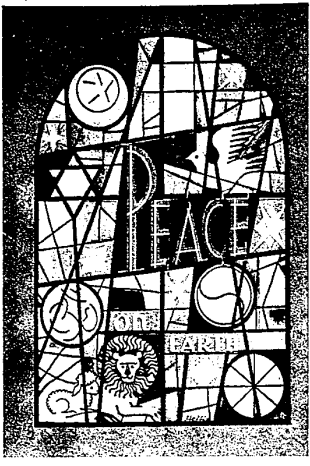


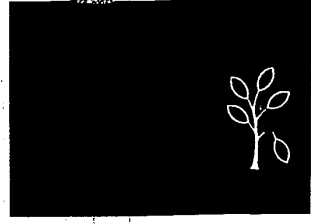
More Christmas Cards Put Money To Work



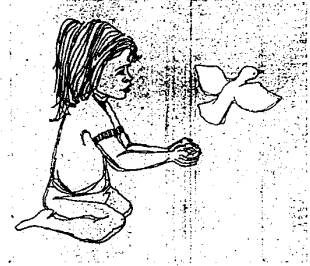

Christians, Politics Topic For Lecture

Politics is not a dirty word but the name for an essential process in modern urban society, contends this month's speaker for the First Thursday Series at St. Gerald Catholic Church in Farmington. Dr. John Forsyth will address himself to the question "How does today's Christian think and live politically?" Dr. Forsyth is director of missions for the Metropolitan Detroit Council of Churches. His talk will take place at 8 p.m. Thursday, Dec. 2, in the church located at 21300 Farmington Road, just north of Eight Mile. In considering political activities for Christians, Dr. Forsyth will talk about his activities as co-chairman of the Metropolitan Detroit chapter of the Coalition on National Priorities, board member of the Urban Alliance and steering committee member for the Clergy and Laymen Concerned about Vietnam. The program will include a question and answer period and small group discussions as well as a short film, "Time Capsule 2."
