HELP!

Snowmobilers are again urged this season to contact DNR personnel at state parks before they leave home to learn whether there is enough snow cover for them to run their machines in these public areas.

Within these state game areas, the DNR has again designated to cross - country tracts for snowmobilers, covering a total of 20,600 acres: Allegan, Shiawassee River, Dansville, Gourdneck, Minden City, Murphy Lake, and Rogue River.
