## Employee Testing Seminar At EMU

**YPSILANTI**  
A two-session seminar on employee testing will be held Jan. 7 in the faculty lounge of McKenney Union at Eastern Michigan University.  
Sponsored by the Bureau of Business Services and

Research at EMU, the seminar is intended to help employers evaluate their testing programs, particularly in light of recent legislation which regulates employee testing.

Seminar leaders will outline techniques for designing tests to comply with federal and judicial guidelines. Lectures and case studies will be used to illustrate successful methods for useful testing of potential employees.

The follow-up session in January will allow each participant to be scored on programs instituted as a result of the first session.

Leading the seminar will be Roger Hawkins, executive director of the bureau and head of the department of general business. Hawkins is an industrial psychologist and management consultant with extensive academic and business experience. Assisting him will be Robert Anderson, professor of psychology at EMU.

Cost of the program is \$100 a person, including tuition, materials and luncheon for both sessions. Companies which enroll two persons may enroll a third at no extra cost. Contact the Bureau of Business Services and Research, Eastern Michigan University, Ypsilanti, 48197.

## VA Cutting 'Red Tape'

As part of a continuing program to "cut red tape," Veterans Administration announced that a lost birth certificate or marriage license will no longer be the big problem it once was for those who apply for veterans benefits.

Less formal proof of marriage and birth is now acceptable under new VA regulations.

Officials noted that a new regulation covers payments of compensation, pension, dependency and indemnity compensation and education benefits for veterans, widows, and orphan children.

They explained that VA now accepts a veteran's certified statement of marriage, provided neither he nor his

wife has been married before, and the agency has no contradictory information on file.

VA also accepts a widow's certified statement of marriage, if agency records substantially support her statement.

Similarly, a veteran's certified statement on the birth of a child of his marriage is acceptable as proof of age and relationship, again, barring VA information to the contrary.

In the case of a deceased veteran, the other parent's certified statement on the birth of the veteran's child is sufficient, provided VA records corroborate the statement.
