Reps Back **Phosphate** Limitation

LANSING

A limit on the percentage of phosphates in laundry detergents sold in Michigan was passed by the State House with approval from Observerland's eight

The bill passed on Dec. 14 in a 99-2 vote.

Voting for passage were Reps. Richard Young (D-Dearborn Heights), John Bennett (D-Redford Township), Marvin Stamplen (D-Livonia), James Tierney (D-Garden City), Thomas Brown (D-Westland), Raymond Baker (R-Farmington), Joseph Forbes (D-Oak Park) and James Defebaugh (R-Birmingham).

Believed to be the first of its kind, the bill will impose an 8.7 per cent limit on the amount of phosphates in laundry detergents and cleaning agents.

It would also give the State Water Resources Commission power to ban what it considers danger-ous substitutes and puts the burden of proof on the manufacturer to prove the substitute doesn't harm health or the environment.

It would become effective on July 1, if signed by
