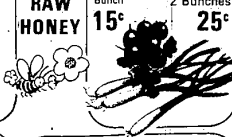

Abortion Suit
Will Be Filed

The Michigan Women's Abortion Suit will be filed Friday, July 9, in Recorder's Court in the City-County Building, Detroit. Some 400 signatures have been collected in the Detroit area and even after filing women will be able to sign.

WOMEN FROM many different areas in Michigan met and decided to launch a class suit demanding repeal of all Michigan abortion laws in May. The suit claims that abortion laws are unconstitutional because they infringe upon a woman's right to privacy and to control over her own body.

Many of the area signers are high school students, including Karen Pavlik, a Churchill High School senior, who is working on the drive for signatures for the Wayne Women's Liberation group. "We aim to get all the laws wiped off the books," according to Miss Pavlik. "If

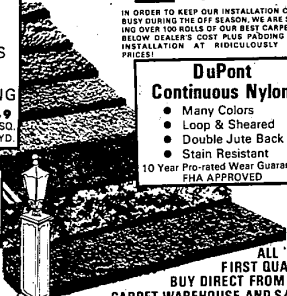
this isn't possible, we hope that the suit may help lift some restrictions." Speakers are available to go out and meet with groups.

Any woman who is a resident of the state, whether or not she has had an abortion, is eligible to be a plaintiff.
