"The board decided that before they tried to equate the sexes they didn't have that problem with hair in the water," Larson explained. "So they decided to go back to the former policy."

The cap policy (including the men) quietly took effect on Monday.

One advantage Larson saw from the experimenting was that now maybe the girls will "understand why it is the way it is."
