### S'craft OKs Maintenance Contract

A program to increase the efficiency of custodial operations at Schoolcraft College will get under way on the campus this week after getting the approval of the board of trustees recently.

The Maintenance Op-timization Program (MOP) was approved after the college had authorized the Mauchley Management Services to conduct an analysis of custodial operations on the campus.

The analysis showed the need for developing new custodial work schedules and custodial work schedules and job assignments, in-service training for supervisory and custodial personnel, and for a complete revamping and upgrading of the department.

The college will pay the Mauchley firm \$36,700 for the analysis and the seven-week intensive program. This expenditure was questioned by board members, but administrators said it will save the college money in the long run.

The firm guarantees a savings to the college of at least the \$36,700 within the first year of adopting its recommendations.
