# Farmington Restaurant Has Western Personality

Farmington's newest restaurant, opened just two weeks ago, has a free and easy Western personality with a French and German accent.

It's the Park Place Restaurant, located in the Freeway Shopping Center, 10 Mile and Grand River, owned and operated by Farmington resident Gail Nau.

**THE WESTERN** emphasis is in the decor of the restaurant in the use of woods and brick. Birch, cedar and redwood are used throughout and the chairs and tables are mellow light oak. Fabrics have been used instead of leather and plastics.

The four dining areas around a central bar are cleverly designed for quiet and privacy, yet are harmonious so there is a feeling of openness.

The French flavor is that of wine, whatever kind you prefer. Three large wooden barrels hold red, rose and white wine, each at the proper temperature. Other wines are

available from the menu and for take-out. And French onion soup is always on the menu.

The German flavor is provided by the two German bartenders, and the fact that Nau is of German extraction.

He's a veteran of the restaurant business. His father has operated the Snow White Restaurant in northwest Detroit for 31 years.

Nau is aiming at the "medium-young trade" (25 to 50 by his definition), and hopes to be able to keep prices as low as possible by attracting more customers than would a more "pretentious" restaurant.

**THE EMPHASIS** will be on a quiet, relaxed atmosphere...with good food. A folksinger, Beverly Carole, provides music Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday evenings.

In the good food department, there's an intriguing item called "steak Dianne." This is a dish which Nau first sampled in Aspen, Colo., and experimented with for three
