The purpose of the scholarship program is to provide financial assistance to young men motivated toward an Army career.

The final selection of the scholarship winners was based upon a subjective evaluation of all facets of the applicant's records, including participation in extra-curricular and athletic activities, demonstrated leadership, apparent interest in a military career, as well as recommendations.

Upon successful completion of military science and bachelor degree requirements, he will be commissioned a second lieutenant in one of the several branches of the U.S. Army.

Rickey is a 1971 graduate of Farmington High School and is now at Michigan State University in the school of scholastic achievement, criminal justice.

## Left Turns Banned At 14 Mile

The Oakland County Road Commission has adopted two traffic control resolutions which will be affecting Farmington drivers.

One will prohibit all left turns from south bound Orchard Lake Rd. onto 14 Mile Rd., to eliminate "a hazardous condition which exists at the intersection."

The other change is on Farmington Rd., between 10 Mile and Glen Orchard, where no parking will be allowed at any time.

Appropriate signs will be installed at both locations in the near future.
