

Mayor Will Pitch First Ball to Open Home Season

Weather in a Teacup

Here is a practical way of telling whether a day is going to be fine or wet. Drop a lump of sugar into a cup of tea and watch the behavior of the bubbles as they rise to the surface. If they appear as if they are carrying to the side of the cup, there to disappear, then the day will be fine. Should the bubbles grow large and float in the center of the cup for some time, then be sure rain is close at hand. The reason? A writer in Pearson's London Weekly answers: The behavior of the bubbles is due to the pressure of the air. When it is high, the bubbles burst quickly; when low, and rain is near, the bubbles remain intact for an appreciable time.
