

CASE INAUGURATES MOTOR SERIAL NUMBER CHECKING

To protect the prospective purchaser of used and new cars from out of state, Leon D. Case, Secretary of State, has recently inaugurated a system of checking motor and serial numbers of cars purchased out of state.

Before the title of the car is delivered, the department of state investigators or branch managers, make a physical investigation of the car to make certain that the actual motor number and serial number on the car correspond to those on the bill of sale or certificate of registration and title of the former state.

By this method it has been discovered in a great many cases that the numbers do not correspond. In such instances the incorrect number is checked against the stolen car report to eliminate the possibility of a dealer or individual buying a stolen car. If no stolen report is found, it is then necessary for the seller to have his home

state correct the error and certify the same before Michigan will issue a certificate of title.

Experience has shown that the average driver has no idea as to whether the motor number on his certificate of title is actually the one embossed on the motor of his car.

TELEPHONE SERVICE GROWS IN BRITISH INDIA

Telephone service is becoming more and more popular throughout British India. A recent estimate, based on the number of long distance calls from seven large cities, showed an increase of more than 75 per cent over the corresponding period during the preceding year.

Telephone service is also being extended in India. During 1932, service was inaugurated between Ceylon and Burma, and a three-channel telephone carrier system was provided between Madras and Bombay, and a single-channel circuit between Madras and Calcutta.
