Filming a jungle film in Hollywood is a costly proposition. Paramount executives found that out after adding up production costs on the new Dorothy Lamour-Ray Milland film.

Except for necessary indoor shots filmed on sound stages at the Paramount studios, almost the entire production was shot at Palm Springs, desert playground of Hollywood socialites.

To make authentic reproductions of the jungle life in the film over \$20,000 worth of trees were brought to the desert spot and replanted. Two weeks of work and two dozen species of flora went into this creation of the man-made "Garden of Eden."

Four tons of rich loam was hauled to the location and a temporary greenhouse was erected before the experts began the tremendous task of transplanting.
