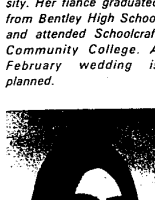
MARIE GELLINGS

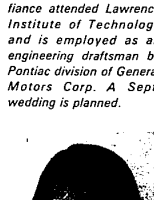
GAIL ANTCAK

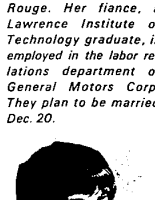
JANICE JONES
