

TUBERCULOSIS COSTS TOO MUCH, SAYS DIRECTOR

Tuberculosis comes too early and stays too late, costing the state of Michigan over four million dollars annually, according to Dr. A. Newitt, director, Bureau of Epidemiology, state department of health.

Long before most victims suspect the presence of the disease, it has become entrenched. Discovery has become infrequent. It takes two to five years to cure. Early detection is necessary to control the disease.
