## 'Freeze' Is Fraud To HRP Delegates

About 100 members of the Human Rights Party gathered in Farmington Sunday to assess progress on their statewide petition drive and to criticize what they termed "the Nixon Wage-Price Fraud."

HRP activists have been irrulating petitions to secure official recognition as a new state political party throughout the summer. Having in hand 12,000 of the required 15,000 signatures, they made plans to conclude the petition drive by next month.
