Bendix Develops Super Detector

A portable radiographic detection system for the inspection of parcels, luggage and briefcases has been developed by Bendix Corporation's Aerospace Systems Division here.

The new system can detect illegal guns, explosives and other contraband materials that may be concealed in various containers, according to J.P. Clayton, general manager of the Bendix division.

The portable Bendix system is compact and lightweight. It employs a short-pulse, low-energy x-ray for rapid and precise inspection of suspect containers.

Key elements of the system are the Bendix-Ray, a compact, low-dose, pulse x-ray unit; a radiographic sensor that converts the low-intensity image obtained from an x-ray pulse to an image of sufficient brightness to be observed by a television camera; a vidicon television camera with a

monitor and an image storage device.

Clayton said the Bendix system is unique in that it can instantaneously yield an x-ray image of a parcel and its contents on a television screen by using only a single, extremely short pulse of radiation.

Easy portability permits operation at any location and provides maximum safety to the operator of the equipment. The radiation dose at the parcel is low enough to allow multiple inspections to be performed without affecting contents such as high-speed film.

Previous inspection systems have relied on electromagnetic detectors or higher x-ray radiation levels, said Clayton. The electromagnetic detector could not discriminate between guns or other metallic contraband and ordinary metal objects. Using significantly lower radiation levels, the new Bendix system provides greater safety for equipment operators and protects objects being inspected.

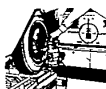
