PONTIAC save the children's time," Mrs. Vickery continued. "However, over a five year period, the school district will have about \$2,000 per year on workbooks."

A court ruling in August, 1970 required school districts to furnish workbooks rather than having them purchased by the students.

Media consultant Denise Jenkins said the laminators are the most frequently used pieces of equipment in a collection that includes transparency makers, slide and tape duplicators, dry-mount poster equipment.

CLARENCEVILLE School District, piloting an individualized reading program, is making heavy use of the laminating process this year.

"We are laminating seven copies of each workbook for each class," explained Mrs. Patricia Vickery, the district's elementary instruction supervisor.

"In this program, we emphasize particular reading skills. Children work in groups of no more than seven. Every child does not need every page of any workbook, so we are giving each child just those pages he needs."

"Our reason for using workbooks this way is actually to

Livonian Jan Mills speaks only Swedish now. There's a good reason, though. Miss Mills is spending the year in Sweden under sponsorship of American Field Service and to become proficient in that Scandinavian language has decided to "give up" English for a year.

Arrangements for her year in Sweden were made by Clarenceville's AFS Chapter.

A GRADUATE of Clarenceville High School, Miss Mills left for Sweden in July, spending a month in the northern part of that country in intensive language study. In August she was welcomed into a Swedish home and will remain with the family until she returns home.

The daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Warren Mills, 20999 Milburn, Livonia, Jan wrote to friends at home that the first month of intensive study is a "must" for all AFS students in Sweden.

"I felt that the month was excellent. One had time to adjust, get used to taking care of himself and learn a little about the country before meeting his family," she related.

She wrote that when her Swedish friends urge her to speak just a little English they have difficulty understanding her. "When I speak English," she wrote, "they have a hard time understanding me as I am not from England and say words like 'after' (American) and not 'after' as the English do."

IN TRANSLATING Swedish to English she finds that "ridiculous things happen to me."
