**Doctors Examine Causes** 

Of High Blood Préssure Patients with high blood pressure should be studied with regard to the effect of posture on the hypertension and those in whom the pressure falls markedly when confined strictly to the recumbent posture should have their urinary tracts studied by X-ray, and if peptroptosis (downward displacement of the kidney) is found some supportive measure for the latter should be instituted, William S. McCanan, M. D. Rochesfer, N. Y., declares in the Journal of the American Medical Association in a paper prepared in collaboration with Monroe J. Romansky, Mt. D. also of Rochesjer.
