KENNEDY URGES CRUSADE TO CUT AUTO FATALITIES

AUTO FATALITIES

With a sharp inpurge in traffic movement already being felt as a result of the defense industrial boom. State Highway Commissioner G. Donald Kennedy this week urged motorists to job in a crusade against the ever-mounting accidental death toll.

"When we stop to realize that Michigan automobile fatalities durine 1940 totaled 1,622," Kennedy said, "we can readily see the necessity for an intensified offensive against this traffic source."

In addition to the increased use of highways because of the national defense program. Kennedy called attention, to the fact that surveys of the 1941 tourist outlook indicate that touring this year will reach record proportions in Michigan.

Said Kennedy:
"There is no doubt but that traffic on Michigan as all time high may here as will see as full time high mark

There is out but that traf-if on Michigan highways this year will set in all-time high mark and greatly surphas the '14 billion while michigan in 1940. As a result, we must be more careful about our driving than ever if many lives are not to be sacrificed mediessly."

While the state highway department is constantly striving to develop a highway system as nearly trouble-proof as it is possible to build, Kennedy pointed out that it is still, up to the individual meterifs if the accident toll is to be held to a minimum.

"Although in the past traffic fatalities have climbed as automobile travel increased, Kennedy said," it is entirely possible to reverse this condition. With safer highways and with motorist realizing the necessity of driving more izing the necessity of driving more cautiously because of conditions created by the increased flow of traffic this death rate can be halted and even reduced."
