8 Sites Approved For FARC

Eight Farmington elementary schools have been approved as sites for the winter program of the Farmington Area Recreation Commission (FARC) by the Farmington Board of Education.

According to a letter sent to the school trustees by Evans Bageris, director of the FARC, tentative plans call for the program to be held on Saturday mornings from Jan. 25 to March 1.

School sites approved to house the program are: Cloverdale, Gill, Kenbrook, Beechview, William Grace, Bond, Shawanawase and Eagle.

Bageris told the board that the commission hopes to sponsor two five-week courses of baseball school instruction from Feb. 9 to April 12. The sites will be selected from the above schools after registration.

Registration for the baseball school will be in late January and February.

FHS Will Serenade Santa

Farmington High School will present its annual Christmas concert, "Santa's Serenade," at 8 p.m. Wednesday, Dec. 18, in the school gymnasium.

Traditional Christmas music will be performed by the symphony band, directed by Robert H. Zimmerman, and the choir. Other guest club, Falcotras and the Twelve Tenors, directed by William Feucht. Tickets may be purchased in advance at the high school for \$1 for adults, 50 cents for students and \$3.50 for family. Tickets purchased at the door will cost an additional 25 cents, except for the family tickets which will remain the same price.

Schools To Sell Two Sites

The Farmington School District will sell two of its one-room schools in February as long as the titles are cleared. One school which will definitely be sold is the old Fairview School on Grand River just east of Halsted Road. The building is no longer used by the district and is completely surrounded by the projected Independence Green apartment development.

The other building is the Nichol School on the west side of Farmington Road north of 13 Mile.

This is the building that the school board directed the staff to determine whether or not the district holds a marketable title, before selling the property.

Sealed bids will be opened at 9 p.m. Monday, Feb. 10, in the board offices for the property.
