

Redford Civic Symphony To Give Concert Oct. 24 **Amusements**

Works by Wagner and Strauss will open and close the first concert of the Redford Civic Symphony scheduled for Sunday, Oct. 24, at 4 p.m. The concert will be held in the Redford Union High School gymnasium, Kinloch and Curtis, under sponsorship

of the Redford Township Music Society. Members of the society are invited to bring guests to this concert. They will be admitted free on the members' cards. Tickets will also be on sale at the door. Memberships are still available for the 1971-72

season. They may be obtained by contacting the president of the society, E.C. Weis, 26078 Graham, Redford Township. Sunday's program will open with Richard Wagner's colorful Overture to the opera "The Flying Dutchman." It will be followed with

"Variations on a Theme by Hadyn," by Brahms and "Summer Evening" by Delius. The closing selection will be a suite from "Die Fledermaus" by Johann Strauss. The symphony has also scheduled a Christmas con-

cert on Dec. 19, featuring the General Motors Chorus; a family concert on Feb. 27, with student participation; and a cabaret concert April 23, which will feature "pop concert" music of the 1930s. A family membership in the society entitles all members of

a family to attend all concerts of the season. In addition, tickets to each of the performances will be available at the door.
