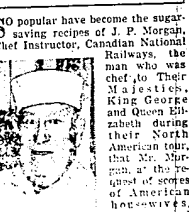
CASSEROLE DISH IS GOOD CHOICE FOR WARM WEATHER

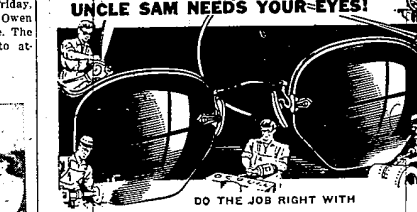
