THE PROGRAM will consist of three substantial works, Rimsky-Korsakov's "Russian Easter Overture,"

the D minor symphony of Cesar Franck, and Leonard Bernstein's "Chichester Psalms." The combined choruses of Wayne State University will join the orchestra for the latter.

The orchestra was organized to provide an opportunity for talented and interested musicians to receive additional orchestral experience in a professionally-oriented environment.

It was also formed to serve as a type of training orchestra for the Detroit Symphony. Proceeds from the concert are earmarked for the orchestra's scholarship fund.

"Rain" is based on a short story by W. Somerset Maugham, entitled "Miss Thompson." It takes place in the South Seas and includes a motley company of American marines and Cockney British sailors; a traveling physician and his wife; Sadie Thompson, a flashy gal who is fleeing the law of California; a missionary, the Rev. Davidson, who is bent on saving Sadie's soul; and his wife.

RALPH KELLY is directing the Masque Players version, which will be produced in modern costume and with modern music. The dialogue will remain the same as when it was first presented in New York in 1922.
