

Plan Goes To Legislature

3 Back No-Fault Insurance Idea

The concept of a no-fault insurance to speed up settlements for damages in automobile accidents has the support of at least three Ob-servers' legislators.

State Reps. Marvin Stempien (D-Livonia), Joseph Forbes (D-Oak Park) and John Bennett (D-Redford Township) said they support the concept because of its advantages to the injured parties.

Several plans have been introduced in the Legislature,

and Gov. William Milliken proposed what is considered one of the more liberal plans this week.

THE IDEA is to immediately reimburse persons for injuries and losses. Persons would carry no-fault policies, and their own insurance company would be liable for the costs, regardless of who was at fault.

Lawsuits resulting from injuries in accidents usually take a long time to settle, and the final settlement is often

eaten up by court costs and lawyer's fees.

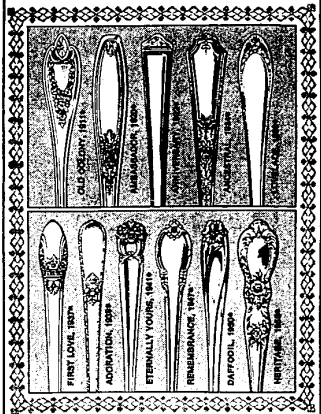
"It is a good idea because we would invest fewer dollars in administration and pay out more dollars to the injured parties," said Stempien, who is an attorney.

Stempien said that the House committee on insurance and the judiciary committee will have extensive work to do on the plans because of critical areas in the proposals.

"We have to assure that there are adequate benefits to the individual and that he will be made whole again," he

Roth Order Can't Be Delayed

District Judge Stephen Roth's order to the State Board of Education to submit plans on desegregating Detroit schools can not be postponed, according to State Rep. Richard Young (D-Dearborn Heights).

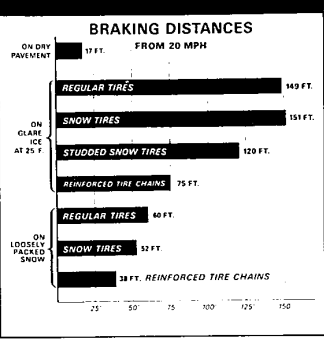
Young, who is a member of an ad hoc committee established to stop the bussing of children from neighborhood schools, said the committee asked Att. Gen. Frank Kelley whether the order could be held in suspension.

Kelley replied that it couldn't but added his office is appealing Roth's finding that "de jure" segregation exists in Detroit's public schools.

Young said the committee is attempting to get a copy of the transcript of the Detroit school board hearing so the Legislature will learn what can be done to upgrade the Detroit system.

"If Judge Roth is sincere that at the end of every bus ride a better education would be present for the bussed student, then it is incumbent upon the Legislature to make certain that the Detroit system is brought up to par with the suburban school districts," Young said. "If this is done, then we can see no reason why children should have to be bussed."

CAN YOU STOP IN TIME?



The above chart, prepared by the Safe Winter Driving League, summarizes latest test findings of the National Safety Council's Committee on Winter Driving Hazards. These tests have disclosed that conventional snow tires are of no help in stopping on glare ice. Studded tires, however, reduce braking distance on ice by 19%, and reinforced tire chains by 50%. Snow tires reduce braking distance on loosely packed snow by 13% and tire chains by 37%.

Regardless of the help provided by this equipment, however, drivers should realize that braking distances on snow and ice are far greater than the normal dry pavement distance.

Manpower Needs Topic Of Survey

Questionnaires to 1,320 employers in Oakland County will be mailed this week in an effort to project the needs for trained manpower over the next five years.

Dr. David Soule, director of vocational education of Oakland Schools, is directing the survey. One employer in every eight will be sampled.

Those who employ fewer than 10 people will be asked to fill out one-page check lists. Employers of more than 10 people will be sent four-page forms covering the various kinds of skills needed in their business.

Employers are asked in each skill category whether they anticipate hiring more or fewer people in that area and what kind of training they require for entry level jobs.

The employers survey is one of three being made to provide information for planning for the four Oakland Area Vocational Centers.

One survey of 15,000 students selected from grades 5-12 in Oakland County schools will determine educational and career plans of students.

A third survey to be conducted in February will sample adult residents of Oakland County's 28 school districts on their current employment status, whether they are seeking work and whether they are aware of the existence of the vocational centers.
