Experts Give Tips On Indoor Garden Care

Success in growing plants indoors depends primarily on the care that you and your green thumb give them. To make your green thumb even greener, Michigan State University ornamental plant experts offer the following indoor gardening tips.

Watering is the most important element in the care of an indoor garden. If plants do not get enough water, they dry out and die. Too much water makes them drown or rot. The proper procedure is to water thoroughly, but only often enough to prevent wilting.

When the plants begin to wilt, water them thoroughly again. Flowering plants require more frequent watering than do foliage plants.

Insert the neck of the funnel into the soil in the pot. Fill the funnel with water; when it empties, fill it again. When water no longer drains from the funnel, stick your finger in the neck so the water will not run out, then remove the funnel.

Only the amount of water that the soil can hold will leave the funnel, never too much. Plants watered in this way usually will not need water again for several weeks.

Wet sphagnum moss on the surface of the planter tends to raise the relative humidity of the air around the plants as moisture evaporates from it.

This high humidity is beneficial to the plants.

EVERY TWO to four weeks, treat the plants in your garden with a solution of water-soluble fertilizer used at the strength recommended on the label. Fertilize only when plants are actively growing.

Do not use dry fertilizers for plants in an indoor garden. They do not dissolve completely and, through buildup, may eventually kill the plant roots.

Remove any white deposits of fertilizer on the surface of the soil and replace with new soil.

PLANTS NEED light for 12 to 16 hours a day. Use a timer to control the length of illumination. As a general rule of thumb, flowering plants need more light (higher intensity levels, rather than longer periods of illumination) than plants grown for their foliage.

About once a week, turn each of the pots in the planter. This encourages even development of the plants.

If the plants get old, sick or oversized, take them out of the planter and replace them with new, healthy, moderate-size plants.

YOU CAN BE sure of watering exactly the right amount if you use a plastic funnel. Use it this way:

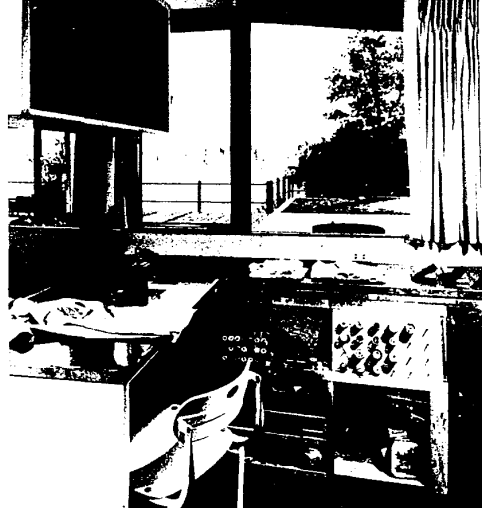
Tile Floors Need Smooth Under Surface

Is there some way to prevent cracks in a wood floor from mirroring through to spoil the appearance of resilient floor coverings? Most applicators of floor tiles prevent this trouble by providing a smooth surface for the new floor covering. Many use hardboard underlayment designed specifically for this purpose.

New Petunia Is A Real Dazzler

A circus means rings and swirling, twirling colorful figures in them. The new Circus petunia gives the effect of rings and movement without really having either.

The blossoms, also, are evenly distributed over the compact plants.

The hybrid vigor bred in this variety shows in the dense foliage. Unusual compactness, rarely over a foot high or more than two feet wide, and a basal branching habit are characteristics of the plants.

A 1972 All-America Selections bronze medalist, Circus has frilly, 3 1/2 to four inch wide flowers with bi-colored petals, the centers rose-red with a salmon tinge, the edges white.

Circus is a grandiflora petunia, freer flowing than many other double varieties. A pot filled with Circus becomes an instant focal point in the garden and a solid bed of Circus is a real dazzler.

It must be the placement of the petals that gives the swirling effect for, actually, the colors are quite evenly divided on each individual
