The Plymouth Symphony's family concert this Sunday afternoon will be notable for its variety.

Six soloists, plus the Middle School East Chorus, have been lined up by symphony conductor Wayne Dunlap to provide an afternoon of interest to area children as well as their parents.

The concert will get under way at 4 p.m., in Plymouth High School Auditorium, Joy and Canton Center Roads. Tickets will be sold at the door as well as at Melody House, 770 Penman, Plymouth.

FIRST ON the program will be Matthew Mischakoff and John Courtney in a mandolin and bassoon version of Mozart's Canonetta from the

opera "Don Giovanni." Mischakoff is the son of Mischa Mischakoff, renowned violinist.

Telemann's Concerto in A minor for recorder, viola da gamba and string orchestra will feature Anne Harter Jones on the viola la gamba. Her husband, Robert W. Jones, will play a harpsichord continuo and Lyle Nordstrom, director of the Collegium Musicum at Oakland University, will play the recorder.

Meryllyn Martin will play Ravel's Introduction and Allegro on the harp.

The second half of the program will begin with a dozen American folk songs by the chorus, directed by William J.

Grimmer. Arranged by D. James, the group includes such well-known favorites as "Blow the Man Down," "Green Grow the Lilacs" and "Somebody's Knocking at Your Door."

THE SYMPHONY will open the program with the "Colas Breugnon" overture to the

"The Master of Clamecy" opera by Kabalevsky. The orchestra will also play Smetana's "Moldau," the second of a set of six national tone poems glorifying Bohemia. This lovely description of a great river begins with a strain in the flute against pizzicato chords in the strings.

The ebb and flow of the waters is reproduced in the strings. Above this, there rises a beautiful folk melody in violins and woodwinds to describe the course of the Moldau. Then a hunting call is heard in the horns, followed by a vigorous peasant dance. The orchestra will bring the afternoon to a close with its

version of the perennial favorite for children, "The Sorcerer's Apprentice" by Dukas.
