August 27, 1943

Dear Enterprise: I am sitting at a table on the mid-deck in our barracks at Great Lakes Training Station. Dick Barrons is sitting next to me writing a letter to his mother. We have been here since August 16th and are going into our second week of the famous "Boo" training. And it sure is a grand life. We work hard, but get good food and plenty of sleep. It is swell to have a fellow from your own home town with you, for a man can get the white-whams and mighty home sick when he is away from the town and the folks he loves. Last week we got our GI haircuts. Dick got his first and when I saw it I laughed so hard tears rolled down my face. But when I got mine, it wasn't so darn funny. You sit in the chair and throw your hat in the air, and when it comes down you have a haircut. That is nearly a fact, because the barbers, four of them, cut 140 heads in two hours and thirty minutes. We get shots in the arm every Friday for the first four weeks. We had our second shots today. Double strength typhoid which were pretty tough on some of the fellows. I understand you send the paper to the fellows when they are in the service, and I sure would like to have it each week. I had my interview for a rating yesterday and got a rating F1 (and) — First Class Machinist Mate. Well it is getting late and I have a big day ahead of me so I think I had better hit the sack.
