4-Woman  
Show Set

A Farmington artist, Valeria Petri, will have her work exhibited in a four-woman show, opening at the Little Gallery in Birmingham Feb. 13, with a reception to meet the artists from 3 to 6 p.m. The exhibit runs through March 11.

This is the first show of its kind since the gallery opened 23 years ago. Works by painters Maggie Citrin of Detroit and Barbara Keidan of Birmingham will also be shown, along with sculptures by Jean Spreen of Beverly Hills.

The gallery, located at 915 E. Maple, is open from 11 a.m. to 6 p.m. every day except Sunday and Monday.

Performances begin at 8:30 p.m., 7:30 on Sundays.

Noted actor Shepperd Strudwick, who is guest artist in residence, will star as Prospero.

New teaching acting styles to a class of BFA students, he has had starring or featured roles in more than 25 New York productions, more than 30 motion pictures and countless television shows, including the winners of two Pulitzer prizes, two Drama Critics' awards and three Academy awards.

Detroit audiences will remember Strudwick for his performances in Arthur Miller's "The Price" and Edward Albee's "Who's Afraid of Virginia Woolf?" at the Fisher Theatre.

He has recently appeared in episodes of "The Name of the Game" and "MacMillan and Wife."

"CHILD'S PLAY." Robert Marasco's Broadway hit, is the second production of the season. The winner of five 1970 Tony awards, it will have its Detroit area premiere on March 9 in The Theatre.

Strudwick will star as Joe Dobbs in this production.

Dr. James W. Rodgers, chairman of the consolidated department for the performing arts, will direct both plays.

The first season in the new theater will close with a new adaptation of Aristophanes' Greek classic "Lysistrata" by David Regal. An original rock score accompanies this comedy, which will open April 6. Regal, who is also a guest artist in residence, will direct it.

The new theater, built by students, seats 500 persons. The project was conceived during Sir Tyrone Guthrie's residency at the University of Detroit in the fall of 1969. The structure was designed by a U of D master's degree candidate, Harold Thruswell, who attended the National Theatre School in Montreal. The construction was under the supervision of Michael Huesman, the technical director.

Parking is available for 500 cars at the theater.

With the addition of the new facility, the schools are now offering an intensive two-year program which leads to a BFA degree in theatre.


