

SANDWICH FILLS DETERMINE SUCCESS OF LUNCH

When those lunch boxes go swinging off to school, the layers between the bread siles determine whether upturned moses or eager griading with the teeth will mark the opening of the lunch. For variety, there's a long list that can be named for sandwich fillers. One such list cottains 23 suggestions offered by the home economics extension service at Wichigan State College.

Cheese combinations can include cottage cheese or cream cheese with jam or Jelly, or American cheese with jam or Jelly, or American cheese with piniento and with pickles.

Other fillings include combina-

Other fillings include combina-tions of egg with green pepper, relish or thousand island dress-ing, celery with cucumber, nuts-or olives, peanut butter with pick-les, apple sauce, jam, hanana, or lettuce or chopped figs, cherries, dates, nuts with pheapple juice. Salmon slaid can gol with egs and pickles, dates and nuts can be used as a filling, lettuce can be dressed up with some preferred

type of dressing.

With these suggestions or any others, the authorities point out, it is best to get an opinion of preferences and check up after the lunch to see which sandwiches would again be desirable.

Sandwich makers can use dried beef, liver loaf, bacon and tomato, fried egg, baked beans, fam or jelly, Spanish onion, sardines, sausage, tomato, banana, left-over ground meat or vegetable mix-tures.


