About Calendars

Calendars are fascinating instruments and under-rated as literary best-sellers. If the truth were known, the calendar each year is better read than the Bible and the Farmer's Almanac combined.

I read the calendar from cover to cover when it first comes out and then scan it each week for additional enrichment.

The 1972 edition has proved as fascinating as previous editions. Having completed the first reading, I can now plot the year with confidence.

THE IMPORTANT items to observe on a first reading are the fifth days in each month. This is of consequence to all and especially important to a community journalist.

I already know, for instance, that I will watch "Laugh-in" only twice during 1972. That's because the city council meets on the first and third Mondays of each month, and the township board on the second and fourth Mondays. Thus, only the fifth Mondays of a month are available for television viewing, and 1972 only has two fifth Mondays.

Another observation quickly made is I will have to attend church four extra times in 1972 because four months have a fifth Sunday. The fact that the year has twice as many fifth Sundays as fifth Mondays might speak well for our nation's welfare this year.

WHAT'S REALLY important, of course, is how many fifth Fridays the year has and in which months they fall.

Because Friday is payday, a fifth Friday means an extra paycheck for that month. Well, 1972 has five fifth Fridays (those who get paid on Thursdays should not be

Director Holko Issues Police Progress Report

FARMINGTON

The Traffic Enforcement Bureau, funded by a federal grant and now in operation in Farmington Township, has already found a reduction of accidents at several high accident areas.

That observation was made by Ronald Holko in the first quarterly report he has filed to the township board since taking over as public safety director last October.

HOLKO reported improvement such as creating a Central Record Bureau, centralizing all police and fire records involving new report forms and logs and a master index card file to provide more accurate statistics.

Plans are also being made to microfilm all records in order to reduce storage area requirements.

Holko has also instituted an in-service training program, with sessions meeting twice weekly, and has sent four officers to various police academies.

An early step taken by Holko was to design a table of organization and to purchase portable radios for patrol officers to provide constant communication with the dispatcher.

ALL THE changes has resulted in a lot of extra time put in by Holko, as reflected in the overtime report for the past 90 days.

Holko himself put in 212 hours of overtime compared to 311 for the entire detective bureau and 970 for the uniform division.

Holko's activities include 27 conferences or speeches, eight staff meetings, two personnel meetings, four fire chief's meetings, and nine press conferences.

During the past 90 days, the department received 9,970 complaints and arrested 249 adults and 170 juveniles. There were 440 accidents reported, including one fatality and 206 injury accidents. A total of 1,190 traffic tickets were issued.

The detective bureau handled 2,115 complaints and recovered stolen property valued at \$38,720.

During the past quarter, police traveled 116,045 miles using 17,800 gallons of gasoline and 245 quarts of oil.

The fire department made 47 fire runs, 21 rescue runs for a total cost of \$4,570. The estimated total fire loss for the last quarter was \$85,200.
