

Contest Recipes To Be Accepted Feb. 1-March 1

Detroit Edison will begin accepting recipes next week for its 11th annual Queen of the Kitchen contest for women who work. Contest dates this year are Feb. 1 through March 1.

From entries received, 10 women will be chosen to take part in a cook-off on Wednesday, March 15. Each finalist will receive an electrical appliance.

THE CONTEST is open to women who are employed full-time outside of their homes and who live within the boundaries of Edison's Southeastern Michigan service area. They are invited to submit a recipe for a main-dish meal based on frozen foods.

Professional home economists and cooks, and employees of Detroit Edison or members of their immediate families are not eligible.

Entries must include name, address, place of employment and telephone number, and should be sent to Edison's Electric Living Division, 2000 Second Avenue, Detroit, 48226, before midnight, March 1.

As in the past, recipes and photographs of the 10 finalists will be published in a handsome booklet for general distribution, free of charge.

THE GRAND PRIZE is a deluxe range and the "queen" will have her choice of top-of-the-line models of ranges which will be displayed that day. An electric hostess set, consisting of fondue pot, hot platter and table broiler, will be awarded as second prize; and the third prize will be a "party pair," including an electric chafing dish and broiler-skillet.

The judges will be food writer Kay Savage; Cynthia Riley, Detroit News household editor; and Lee Murray, consumer consultant for the American Dairy Association of Michigan. Contestants must be able to compete in the cook-off which will be held in Edison's Electric Living Kitchen in Detroit on March 15. Decision of the judges in the selection of the finalists and cook-off winners will be final.

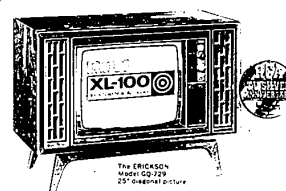
