Cabbage Worms
Cabbage and its relatives caulifower, brecoil, brussels sprouts, stale, knhirbh and chinese cabbage are often severely damaged by vely green cabbage worms which chew holes in the claves and eat their way into the heads, leaving unpleasant deposits of moist green or brown pelits of moist green or brown pelits of excrement. Rotenone dusts or sprays are the-best and safest materials to control this pest. They should be directed down into the developing heads and to both surfaces of the jouter leaves.
