**PLANS TO STAFF HOSPITAL ARE FEATURED**  
 Plans to staff hospitals in Ethiopia with Christian physicians and nurses, and to extend work into vast sections of Africa calling for mission schools and clinics, will be featured by the Sabbath School of the Grandville Seventh-day Adventist Church in a special program Saturday morning at 9:30. Ethiopian hospitals operated by the Adventists at the request of Emperor Haile Selassie before the Italian occupation have been reopened, it is reported, and will continue their work.  
 Leaders announce that other missions projects highlighted during the quarter by Sabbath schools the world around, and for which special funds are provided this week, include a medical center in the ancient city of Baghdad, the securing of an Adventist doctor for Jerusalem, and the relocation of their training school now in Beirut, Syria. It is reported that this school has, during the past five years, sent sixteen young men into the Holy Bible lands as teachers and preachers. One of its out-schools is described as located two miles from the ruins of Nineveh, and having a staff of six teachers and an enrollment of 150 pupils. Hydrotherapy treatment rooms now operating successfully in Jerusalem will soon be enlarged into a hospital, with a physician and nurse in charge, according to plans.  
 Church leaders here have just received word from the Adventist General Conference at Washington, D.C., that six young missionary couples have recently gone to Egypt, Syria, Palestine and Iran. These are young ministers and their wives, who have been given training at the Adventist Theological Seminary in the Arabic language and in the customs of the Mohammedan peoples.

**HOROWITZ TO PLAY AT MASONIC AUDITORIUM**  
 When Vladimir Horowitz, the great Russian-American pianist who comes to the Masonic Auditorium for a recital on Wednesday evening, January 17th, returned to this country last winter, after an absence of nearly five years. America found a new Horowitz — a Horowitz whose genius was finally and completely fulfilled. The sensational virtuoso, the tabular pianist with the heavenstirring fingers, had developed into a mature artist whose musicianship matched his pyrotechnics.  
 His return, a signal for wild enthusiasm from press and public everywhere, culminated with a performance of the Brahms B flat concerto on the occasion of the NBC Symphony Orchestra, a memorable performance later recorded. Horowitz was born in Kiev, Russia, on October 1, 1904, in a house on Muskalnyi Pereulok, meaning, roughly, the Street of Music. Despite this name, however, he was no infant prodigy. He didn't begin to play the piano until he was six. His mother, gifted amateur pianist and graduate of the local conservatory, was his first teacher. Later, he studied under Sergei Tarnowsky, at fifteen he was handed over for finishing to Felix Blumenfeld, composer, teacher, conductor and intimate of Russia's famous group of "Five."

**Chard a Beet Species**  
 Although chard's great nutritive value as a source of vitamins A, B and C, was unknown in the first year, gardeners were then attracted to it by the huge yield which could be obtained from one row, cut constantly all through the summer, until the fall freezeup.  
 Chard is a species of beet which can be sown as soon as the ground will be high enough to begin cutting. For the best quality, leaves should never be allowed to grow more than 10 inches tall. Leaves which reach this size should be cut, and smaller ones left to grow, providing a continuous harvest of young tender leaves throughout the season.
