Ship Lunes

That ships at sea must be ventilated like buildings on land every-body knows, but that they must also "breather" while under construction everybody does not know. Every hull on the ways has "lungs" in the form of blowers, sheetmetal piping and flexible metal hose. A 20,000-ton hull for a troopship needs nearly two-thirds of a million cubic feet of air every hour. Hence Jumbo blowers are placed at strategic selects. Feeder lines from the bioders are tapped at intervals to ventilate the hold by means of air hose. All this appearatus and much piping must be removed before the ship is launched.
