Young Bess — Margaret Irwin.
When Queen Bess was a child she was a possible, but not likely, heir to the English throne, for her mother, Anne Boleyn, had ended with his execution her and bastardizing their daughter.

He dominates the scene and young Bess regards him with mingled horror and fascination. Three stopmothers have been rapidly disposed of, but the fourth, Catherine Parr, manages to outlive Henry and marries Bess's step-uncle, Tom Seymour, whose eldest brother becomes Lord Protector of the boy, King Edward VI.

There follows a furious struggle for power between the Seymour brothers, complicated by the dangerous mutual attraction between Tom Seymour and the "odd difficult girl," Bess. The Protector claps his brother into the Tower on charges of poisoning his wife and abducting the young princess in order to marry her and seize the throne.

This struggle reveals the future greatness of Elizabeth. Practically imprisoned, friendless and alone, this girl of fifteen not only fights for her reputation but for her life, until she forces her enemies to establish her innocence. The book ends with the death of her young brother, King Edward, and Bess while still in her teens, is again at the vortex of a fight for sovereign power. But the danger revolves all her hope and belief in the great destiny that awaits her.

Already in the period this book covers she shows her genius for statecraft, as well as unexpected flashes of a curiously moving simplicity, also of deep capacity for passion, and for poetry. Here again are all the zest and color of historical figures woven into rich, imaginative literature.

COMMISSIONERS' PROCEEDINGS

Special meeting of the City Commission of the City of Farmington was held May 23, 1945. Meeting called to order by Mayor Hamlin at 9:00 p.m.
Commissioners Present: Nacker, Baginall, Hinger, Hatten, Conroy and Jones.
Meeting called for the purpose of considering petition to amend Ordinance C-18 known as the Zoning Ordinance.
The petition reads as follows: To the Commission of the City of Farmington Honorable Sirs:

Your petitioner, Warner Dairy Company, a Michigan corporation, respectfully represents unto your Honorable Body as follows:—

1. That it is the owner of premises located on the South side of Grand River in the City of Farmington, Oakland County, Michigan, in Lapham's Addition to the City of Farmington, in which is included the following parts or parcels, more particularly described as follows:

a. The South 50 feet of the East 12 feet of Lot 1.
b. The South 50 feet of Lot 2.
c. The South 50 feet of the West 24 feet of Lot 3.
d. The East 29 feet of Lot 14.
e. All of Lot 12.

2. That parcels (a), (b), and (c) are now located in Commercial "A" district and parcels (d) and (e) are located in Residence "A" district.

3. That the premises lying immediately South of parcel (a), (b), and (c) are designated on the Zoning Map as Industrial and that the premises adjoining parcels (d) and (e) on the North and on the East are also designated Industrial.

4. That because of the location of said premises and the surrounding area, the said premises may be best used for industrial purposes.

5. That it is proposed to use said above described parcels, together with a portion of Lot 35 which is now designated on the Zoning Map as an industrial district for the erection of a box manufacturing plant; that the old frame building formerly used as the Farmington Dairy, which is an extremely dangerous fire hazard will be immediately removed and new modern buildings erected in its place and stead, all of which will be a benefit to the community at large.

Wherefore Your Petitioner Prays that this Honorable Body forthwith amend and change the Zoning Map of the City of Farmington in the respects hereinabove set forth and that your petitioner be given such other and further relief in the premises as may be agreeable to your Honorable Body and in conformity with the provisions of the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Farmington.

Motion made by Baginall and supported by Hinger that this Ordinance C-18 known as the Zoning Ordinance, be advertised and go through the required number of readings as required by law, and that this reading on May 23rd, 1945 be considered the first and second readings. First reading to be read at our regular meeting June 13, 1945.

In pursuance of and in accordance with authority granted by Act 207 of the Public Acts of Michigan for 1921 and amendments thereto, the City of Farmington Ordains: That part of Ordinance No. C-18 (known as the Zoning Ordinance) which is referred to in Section 2 therein as the Zoning Map of the City of Farmington shall be amended as follows:

1. That the following property located on the south side of Grand River Avenue in the City of Farmington, in which is included the following parts or parcels, more

particularly described as follows:

a. The South 50 feet of the East 12 feet of Lot 1.
b. The South 50 feet of Lot 2.
c. The South 50 feet of the West 24 feet of Lot 3.

Parcels (a), (b), and (c) to be changed from Commercial "A" District to Industrial District.
d. The East 29 feet of Lot 14
e. All of Lot 12.
Parcels (d) and (e) to be changed from Residence "A" District to Industrial District.

2. That parcels (a), (b) and (c) are now located in Commercial "A" District and parcels (d) and (e) are located in Residence "A" District.

3. That the premises lying immediately south of parcels (a), (b), and (c) are designated on the Zoning Map as Industrial and that the premises adjoining parcels (d) and (e) on the North and on the East are also designated Industrial.

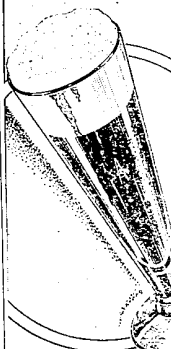
