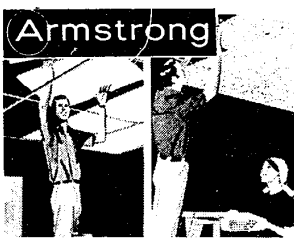




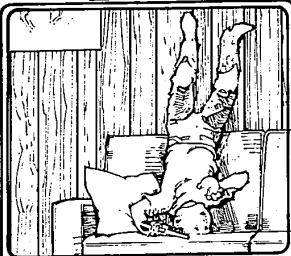

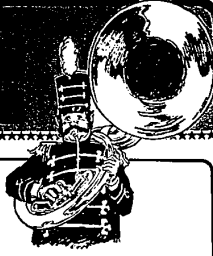

## Red Cross Bloodmobile Relocates

Red Cross announced today the relocation of the Livonia blood donor center. In the past, the Red Cross has collected blood at the Livonia Elks Club, but has moved operations to St. Matthew United Methodist Church, 39900 Six Mile Road, Livonia.

The first and third Thursday of each month, the Red Cross bloodmobile will be at the church site from 2 - 8 p.m.

Individuals may visit the new bloodmobile location to become a member of the blood program "family plan." Under the plan, if one member of the family donates at least one unit of blood per year, the entire family will be covered should illness or accident strike.

"People tend to put off providing for blood coverage until someone in their family suddenly needs blood for surgery," Bill Bucinski, Red Cross blood program field representative said. "For the single unit of blood each year, you can put an end to your blood need worries."

He added that blood will be provided for you, your spouse, your children under 18, children over 18 who cannot donate, parents and parents-in-law, grandparents and grandparents-in-law, and brothers and sisters of an unmarried donor.

## 7 S'craft Faculty Get Full Status

Seven Schoolcraft College faculty members were granted "full status" (comparable to tenure) by the board of trustees.

The faculty members served a two-year probationary period prior to being given full status.

## High School Journalism Contest Set

The seventh annual Detroit Press Club Foundation awards for high school journalism students has been announced.

Dr. Austin Smith, chairman of Parke, Davis & Co. and head of the awards committee, said the deadline for entries is March 20.

The contest is open to senior grade level high school students in Wayne, Oakland and Macomb counties who will be graduating this June.

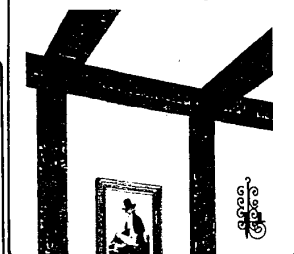
Dr. Smith said entries should consist of published news or feature articles written by high school students which appeared in the school newspaper during the calendar year 1971.

Further details can be obtained from the journalism advisor at each high school in the tri-county area.

The first place winner is given a \$4,000 president's scholarship award. Second place receives \$300, third place, \$200 and fourth, \$100. The awards will be presented at a banquet on May 4.

Through the first six award dinners, the Press Club Foundation has distributed nearly \$50,000 to approximately 150 professional and student newsmen in order to promote the profession of journalism in Michigan.

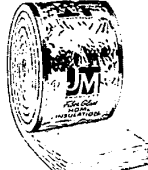
