

Easter Eggs You Can Make

From the White House lawn to millions of beribboned baskets in American homes, brightly decorated Easter eggs are colorful reminders of the season.

This year let the children join in the fun of making the eggs as well as finding them. And there's an additional bonus for them as the eggs are unearthed - they're as good to eat as they are to look at. The Bonbon Eggs are made with a no-cook fondant filled with a choice of either a no-cook peanut butter coconut or chocolate candy.

It is all fun to make, fun to eat and a really special delight for the children.

Before starting the recipe, decide whether you want to fill the egg with a peanut butter coconut candy or with a chocolate candy, or whether you want to fill some with peanut butter and some with chocolate.

If you make both candies to use as the centers, you will have leftover candy - a condition that is never a problem when there are children around to eat up the leftovers.

BONBON EASTER EGGS
1 recipe No-Cook Fondant
1 recipe Peanut Butter Coconut Candy

and/or
1 recipe Chocolate Candy
Confectioners sugar frosting
Prepare fondant, divide into three parts and knead a drop or two of food coloring into each piece, using a different color for each. Chill until ready to form eggs. Prepare Peanut butter coconut candy and/or chocolate candy; cut each batch into 36 small pieces and shape each into a ball; chill.

• Cut each of the three pieces of fondant into 12 pieces. Flatten each piece to 1/4-inch thickness with hands. Wrap pieces around candy. If using both candies wrap half the pieces around peanut butter coconut centers and use the other half around chocolate candy. Form each into egg shape. Decorate with confectioners sugar frosting piped through decorating tube. Makes 36 small decorated eggs plus 18 small candies of each type.

NO-COOK FONDANT
1/3 c. margarine
1/3 c. light corn syrup
1 t. vanilla
1/4 t. salt
1 lb. confectioners sugar, sifted
Food coloring

Blend margarine, corn syrup, vanilla and salt in large mixing bowl. Add confectioners sugar all at once. Mix together, first with spoon, then kneading. Turn onto board and continue kneading until mixture is well blended and smooth.

PEANUT BUTTER CANDY
1/4 c. creamy peanut butter
1/4 c. dark corn syrup
2 t. water
1 1/2 c. sifted confectioners sugar
3 T. nonfat dry milk (dry form)

1/4 t. salt
1 (3 1/2-ounce) can flaked coconut
Mix peanut butter and corn syrup. Stir in water. Mix together confectioners sugar, nonfat dry milk and salt. Stir into syrup mixture. Add coconut. Knead until thoroughly blended.

CHOCOLATE CANDY
1 T. margarine
1/4 c. light or dark corn syrup
1 ounce unsweetened chocolate, melted
1/4 t. vanilla
1 1/2 c. sifted confectioners sugar
1/3 c. nonfat dry milk (dry form)
Mix margarine and corn syrup until well blended. Stir in chocolate and vanilla. Mix confectioners sugar and nonfat dry milk. Gradually add to syrup mixture. Stir, then knead until thoroughly blended.

CONFECTIONERS SUGAR FROSTING
1/4 c. margarine
1/4 lb. confectioners sugar, sifted
Food coloring
Water, if necessary
Mix margarine and confectioners sugar, beating until smooth. Mix in desired coloring. Press through decorating tube, to make desired shapes. Flowers, leaves etc. may be shaped several weeks ahead, wrapped in plastic wrap and stored in refrigerator or freezer. If frosting becomes too stiff, blend in a few drops water.
