C'ville Symphony Ex-Teacher Band Rates 'I' Files Suit In C'ville

Clarenceville High School Symphony Band drew a Division I rating and its Concert Band a Division II rating at the Southeastern Michigan Band District Festival held last Saturday in Monroe.

Judged on rhythm, tone, technique, intonation and interpretation, the Symphony Band drew virtually all "A" ratings in each category. Comments from the adjudicators included: "A nice performance and the band has a lot of self discipline—This band clearly shows some excellent instruction."

Clarenceville's high school instrumental music instructor is John Nettek.

Required number for the Symphony Band was "Dance and Intermzzo" by Carter. Its march was "Nobles of the Mystic Shrine" by Sousa and the selected number was "Masque" by McBeth.

March composition for the Concert Band was "Coat of Arms" by Kenny. Its required composition was "Chorale and Capriccio" by Giovanni. Selected number was "Music for a Ceremony" by Morrissey.

A former Clarenceville High School (CHS) teacher, who was fired by the Clarenceville school board in 1969, has filed a \$500,000 civil suit against the district in U.S. District Court.

Joseph E. Kerr, an English instructor at the high school from the 1967-68 and 1968-69 school years, has filed the suit in federal court, which issued a summons to the school district last week.

Boy, 15, Beaten In School

A 15-year-old Clarenceville High School student who has twice been assaulted while in school has become the concern of the Clarenceville Board of Education.

The parents of Michael Sullivan met with the school board behind closed doors for two hours at the school board meeting Thursday night. After that session, the meeting was reopened to the public, and the board and the boy's parents together agreed that they were unsure about what could be done.

Sullivan was seriously injured Jan. 20 when a youth came up behind him and kicked him in the groin. A 16-year-old Livonia youth pleaded guilty in juvenile court Thursday to a charge of assault and battery in connection with that assault and was given a suspended sentence.

On March 7, when Sullivan was excused from his fifth hour class to go to his locker and get a pencil, he was assaulted by three youths, he told police.
